

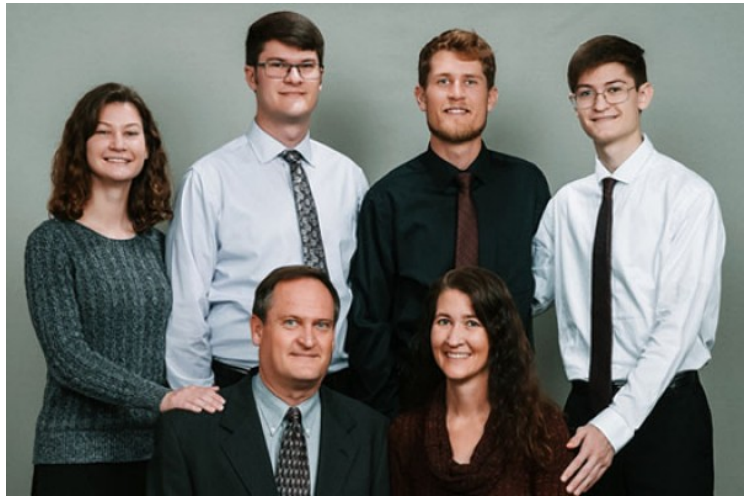
We welcome John and Priscilla Kunkle to our pulpit today!

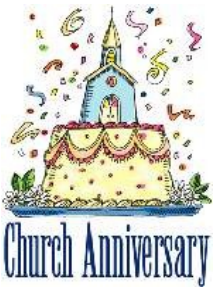
